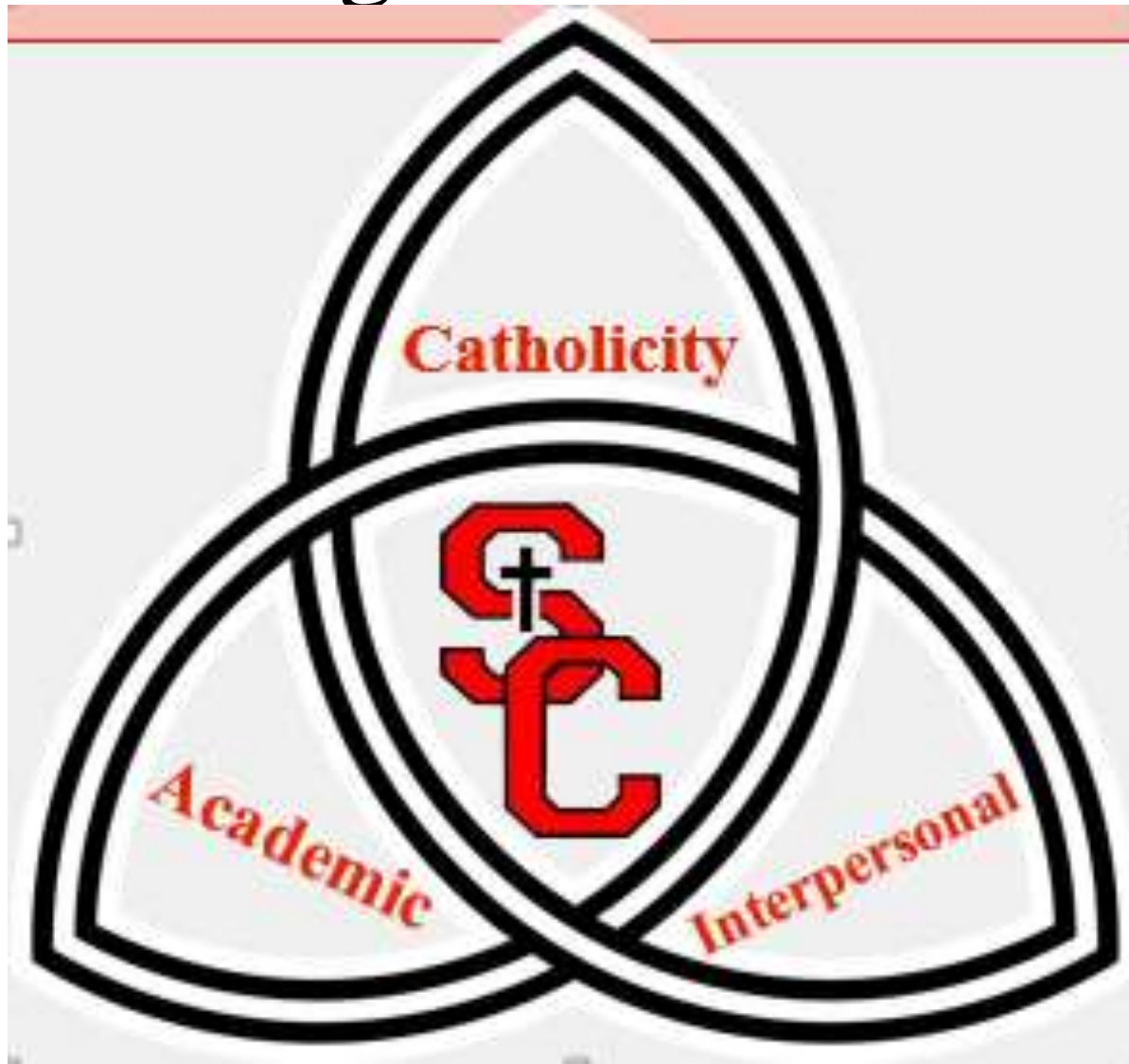

- ▶ Increased student instruction in reading and math.
- ▶ All homerooms will score at grade level or above for reading.
- ▶ All homerooms will score at grade level or above for math.

# General Information

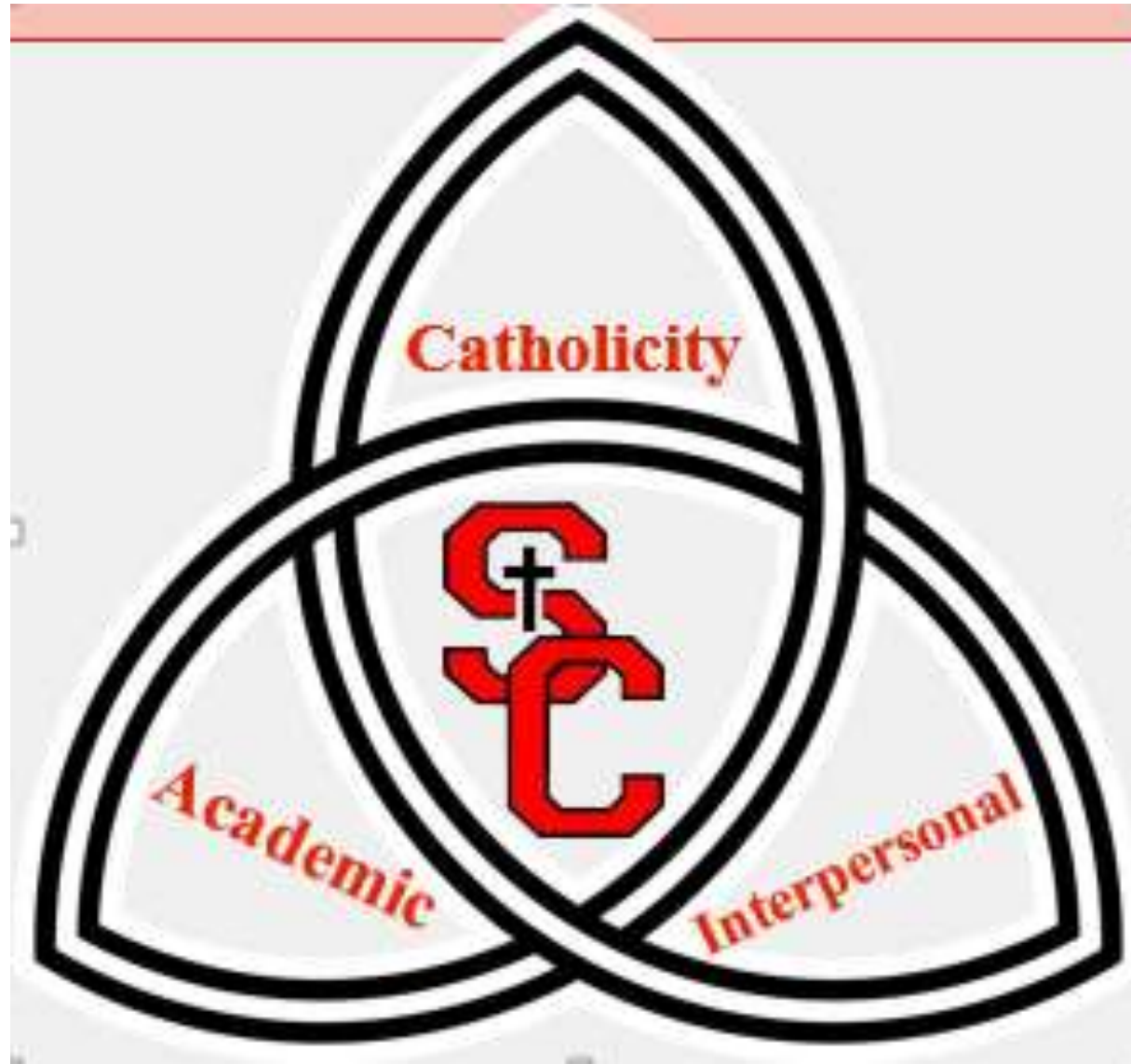
- ▶ Tuition and fees roughly account for 79% of our revenue budget for next year.
- ▶ Fundraising and other revenue account for the remaining 21% of our revenue budget for next year.
- ▶ Total payroll accounts for 74% of our expense budget.
- ▶ Taxes, utilities, maintenance, and instructional materials account for the remaining 26% of next year's expense budget.
- ▶ Catholic School teachers make 25% or 10K less than public school teachers across levels and years of experience.

# Technology Vision

- ▶ Professional development regarding technology integration for instruction.
- ▶ Evaluate technology infrastructure and firewall vulnerability for student tablets.
- ▶ With proper funding, begin the process of phasing in student digital tablets beginning with 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- ▶ Evaluate and observe class instruction to ensure technology integration.
